Dear Parent,

If your child has a known allergy and will require emergency medication to be maintained at Living Savior Preschool, a ***Written Medication Consent Form*** for each medication is mandatory.

This form must be completed in full and signed by your child's physician and the parent or legal guardian and submitted along with the emergency medication/s **before** your child may begin school. The ***Written Medication Consent Form*** must be turned in with all medications and administration tools. **This must be done before your child's open house date.** *Please call the preschool office at 703-352-4208 to make an appointment to go over your child's Written Medication Consent Form(s) and Medication(s) with office personnel.*

Administration Tools and Medication Label Requirements

1. Medication must have a current expiration date and be in the **original packaging labeled with the child's first and last name.**
2. Administration tools such as dosing spoons, medicine cups, oral medication syringes, etc. must be provided by the parents. All administration tools must be **labeled with the child's first and last name.**
3. For the safety of your child, **LSP will not accept any medication(s) that expire during the school year.**
4. Prescription medication should be in its **original packaging** with the **original pharmacy label** that includes the following items:
 - Child's First and Last name
 - Authorized prescriber's name
 - Pharmacy name and telephone
 - Date prescription was filled
 - Name of the medication
 - Route of administration
 - Dosage of the medication
 - How often to give the medication
 - Expiration Date
